

**ARRT STRUCTURED EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR MAMMOGRAPHY
EFFECTIVE: JANUARY 1, 2016**

Beginning January 1, 2016, candidates for post-primary certification and registration will need to meet the Professional Education Requirements specified in the *ARRT Rules and Regulations*. Structured education must be completed within the 24 months prior to submitting the application.

The requirements for Mammography are listed below. Beginning November 2015, candidates will be able to document structured education activities by logging into My ARRT Info on the ARRT website.

Candidates for Mammography Certification and Registration must document at least **16** hours of structured education.

Structured education documentation must include at least one CE credit or its equivalent in each content area listed below (i.e., Patient Care, Image Production, and Procedures). The remaining hours may be earned from any one or more of the content areas.

Patient Care (includes) 1. Patient Interactions and Management	<i>6.75</i>
Image Production (includes) 1. Equipment Operation and Quality Assurance	<i>11.50</i>
Procedures (includes) 1. Anatomy, Physiology, and Pathology 2. Positioning and Procedures	<i>18.00</i>
Interim Policy Credits	<i>3.75</i>
Total	<i>40.0</i>

This credit distribution is subject to change when courses in RadComm’s Initial Training Mammography Program are revised. Our program satisfies the ARRT content requirement for structured education. 40 Category A credits are assigned following successful completion.
